The Council of State Governments (CSG) is partnering with the Department of Defense (DoD) and the Federation of State Massage Therapy Boards (FSMTB) to support the mobility of licensed professionals through the development of new interstate compacts. These compacts will create reciprocity among participant states to reduce the barriers to license portability and employment.

CSG and DoD invites licensed massage therapists, massage therapy regulators, and other industry stakeholders to a kickoff meeting to launch the initiative on Thursday, **May 13, 2021 at 2 p.m. EDT via Zoom.**

Participants will learn about the background and aspirations for the project; the form and function of interstate compacts and the compact development process; and the need for license reciprocity in the massage therapy profession. There also will be a Question and Answer session with CSG, DoD, and industry experts.
